## HOW SHOULD I LEAVE MY ROOM?

- Make sure your room is clean (including floors, walls and ceiling).
- Remove all your personal belongings (unless you have agreed that the new tenant will buy them from you).
- Don't forget to empty the storage room and outside areas.

Unpainted windows and doors.

White ceiling.

No stickers, sticker residue or adhesive plastic.

Walls are painted in a light colour (repaintable in one coat) and can be wallpapered. Free of holes, thick layers of wallpaper, wall plugs, etc.

Make sure your bathroom is mould-free, clean (i.e. descaled) and the drains are unblocked.

The central heating pipes and radiator are white in colour (or a variant of white) and only painted using radiator paint.

Don't forget to clean the kitchen thoroughly (descaling and unblocking drains included).

Remove your self-installed flooring, and leave a smooth surface, free of holes and adhesive residues. If you have agreed for the new tenant to take over the flooring, you may leave it.

Sockets and switches must be unpainted, undamaged and securely fixed.

*Painted sockets can be cleaned by disassembling them, soaking them in water for a night and then cleaning them.*
